
Parade Entry Instruction/Read Carefully

Parade Schedule

- > The Parade will commence promptly at 9:00 A.M.
- > All entry numbers <u>###</u> should be placed on **RIGHT SIDE** of Vehicle/Float.
- > Please be on time, if late, your entry will be placed towards the back of parade.

Parade Route

- > Parade LINE-UP will start at 8:00 A.M. at East side of OEH Office & Mercy St.
- > Be aware that certain areas will be **BLOCKED-OFF** for parade route.
- Enter the parade route from BIA office, West to 3-way turn then North to Crownpoint Jr. High Middle School parking lot
- The Parade will start from BIA Office, then north up towards Office of Youth Department/High School on Eagle Drive.
- > End of Route will be at Crownpoint Jr. High Middle School Parking Lot.



# PARADE ROUTE

Parade Guidelines:

As a participant of the parade, we require that you adhere to the following guidelines:

- The parade theme should be prominently displayed on your entry.
  <u>Theme: "The Essence of Perseverance through the 1868 Navajo Treaty"</u>
- Entry number (s) can be picked up starting on <u>June 19<sup>th</sup></u>, 2018 at 8:00 A.M. at Crownpoint Chapter.
- > We strongly recommend that you bring water for your float.
- Individuals seated on the hood of a vehicle will be required to use an anti-skid foam or grip rope for safety.
- All fire extinguishers should be up-to-date, charged & accessible; and have a minimum capacity of 5lbs and is required on all floats.
- Safety chains are required on all floats.
- DO NOT THROW anything/or objects from a moving vehicle. Walking participants may distribute items (flyer, candy, bottled water, etc.).
- > All entries for the parade are **<u>NON-REFUNDABLE, FREE PARADE ENTRY.</u>**
- Non-compliance with these guidelines will result in Disqualification in Parade Participation.
- You are responsible for picking up any trash during dismantling of your float immediately after the parade.
- This is a FREE Event, NO Drugs or Alcohol allowed Alcohol and Tobacco FREE EVENT.
